Guardian article 11.06.25 'Sedentary, scrolling and alone'

'Children are growing up 'sedentary, scrolling and alone' because of a dramatic decline in play in their lives', say a panel of experts who have spent a year investigating play and childhood in England.

'The reason we don't have time to play,' one year 7 child said, 'is because we've got stress ... we're doing homework.'

'I've been a Head for 22 years ... we are now trying to cram far more learning into the same length of day. The curriculum means that for children from six or seven years old, play is gone ... it's brutal. The classroom is changing from a free-flow space to what is more like an office.



Bounce Bezulah in the air (x 3) Let the wind blow through in her ****


Bounce Bezulah to and fro (x 3) Round and round and round she'll ****




